- UPCOMING SPAN EVENTS
  - Sept. Board meeting has been canceled due to CNIP and Stich events. Next Board meeting will be Oct. 25<sup>th</sup>.
  - CNIP Event: Sept. 27<sup>th</sup>, Morrison Library. City staff will provide an update on CNIP projects and time schedule. There will be brief presentations at noon and 6 pm and drop in times during the day.

- REZONING ACTIVITY
  - Sharon Towers rezoning vote will be Sept. 10. We are still waiting on revisions to dev. Standards from city.
  - Lincoln Harris is filing a petition to rezone a vacant parcel on Carnegie for 180 ft. office building.
  - Construction for the Colony project is scheduled for early April. The lawsuit that had delayed project has been settled.
- TREASURER REPORT
  - Treasurer has sent out renewal notices to those members who paid last summer.
  - There are 52 neighborhoods/condo or civic associations within the SP area.
  - SPAN has 18 paid members representing majority of residential population
  - We have \$1,500 in bank account.
- SPEAKER- Brian Leary Crescent Communities
  - Brian discussed differences between development activity in Atlanta and Charlotte and provided insight into what might be next for the SouthPark area.
  - Stressed the need for a blueprint to guide development and continued infrastructure improvements.
